Classes

ATV YOUTH CLASSES

1. 0-50cc
2. 51cc-125cc
3. 126cc-250cc (no 250R's)

YOUTH DIRT BIKE CLASSES

1. 0-70cc 2 & 4 stroke
2. 71-150cc 2 & 4 stroke

ADULT ATV CLASSES

1. 200cc-250cc 2 stroke (Blaster's 250R's)
2. 250cc-350cc 4 stroke
3. 350cc-400cc 2 stroke (TRX 450R's)
4. 401cc-UP 4 stroke

ADULT DIRT BIKE CLASSES

1. 400cc & below
2. 401cc & above

UTV CLASSES

1. 0-700cc Non-Turbo
2. 701cc-999cc Non- Turbo
3. 1000cc & up Turbo
4. Utility

OPEN MONEY CLASSES \$25.00 ENTRY FEE (50% PAYBACK)

1. ATV (no bikes)
2. Dirt Bikes
3. Open (ATV, BIKES, SXS)

General Rules

Entry Fees and Pit Access

- Pit entry is \$15.00 per person.
- Each rider's first class is included with the pit fee.
- Additional classes are \$15.00 per class.
- Pit entry does not include amusement rides.

Release Waivers and Armbands

- Everyone 18 years of age or older who enters the pit area must sign the required release waiver before entering. Anyone under 18 years of age must have the required waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian before entering the pit area, whether the minor is a rider or a spectator.
- Armbands must be worn at all times.
- Lost armbands, or failure to wear an armband, will require purchasing a replacement armband for \$15.00.

Class Requirements and Event Format

- All classes are double elimination.
- Each class must have a minimum of four riders.
- Only one rider is permitted per vehicle, per class.
- Ox Hill reserves the right to change classes or rules at any time, for any reason.

Conduct

Disorderly conduct and fighting will not be tolerated. Anyone engaging in this behavior will be dismissed from the fairgrounds immediately. All alcoholic beverages and substances are prohibited and are not to be brought on to the fairgrounds at any time.

Risk, Responsibility, and Insurance

Motorsports are inherently dangerous. Riders should participate only within their own abilities, or their child's abilities, and are responsible for the quality and condition of their vehicle and protective gear.

Riders and spectators enter at their own risk. The Ox Hill Fair and the promoter do not provide medical insurance coverage. Riders are urged not to compete in any motorsport without adequate personal medical insurance. Spectators who attend these events assume all risks for any injury or damage that may result.

Track Conditions

Dirt drags are held on uneven sand or dirt tracks, unlike asphalt racing surfaces. The Ox Hill Fair Association will make reasonable efforts to maintain a suitable racing surface; however, competitors should expect possible holes, low spots, mud, ridges, uneven areas, rocks, or other debris on the track. Riders are encouraged to stay aware of their surroundings during test runs and take note of track conditions.

Rider and Machine Safety

Required Rider Gear

- Approved DOT helmet
- Safety eyewear protection
- Closed-toe boots or shoes
- Long pants and a shirt
- Riding gear, recommended

ATV and Dirt Bike Safety

- All machines must have operating brakes.
- All youth classes are required to have tether kill switches.
- All adult classes are recommended to have tether kill switches.

Pit Area Rules

- The pit area is idle speed only.
- No burnouts, wheelies, tailspins, or excessive speeds are permitted in the pit area.
- Riders must stay with their machine during their class.
- Riders must use caution at all times while riding in the pit area.

Race Rules

- Riders will receive a rider number, which must be pinned to the front of their chest so officials can clearly identify each rider during class line-ups.
- A manual tree will be used at the starting line.
- No race will begin until the previous riders are off the track.
- After each loss, an official will mark the rider's number to record the lost pass. Losing riders must stop at the official to receive this mark.
- After each race, riders must immediately return to either the winner's lane or the loser's lane and prepare for the next pass.
- Once a rider has two losses, they are disqualified from the competition and must immediately return their machine to their pit spot in a slow and cautious manner.
