PA FAIR Goat Health Requirements for Departments 6, 10, 11

1. Pennsylvania goats must have verification of a veterinary-client-patient relationship. A current Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) is required and must be completed within the 30 days prior to the fair.
2. Animals appearing unhealthy or showing visible signs of contagious disease, upon arrival may not enter the fairgrounds.
3. Individual Official USDA scrapie animal identification is required. Official scrapie I.D. includes:
 - (a) A USDA ear tag with a US shield ; which includes scrapie program tags (animals bearing identification with blue colored scrapie program tags labelled “meat” with a US shield are not permitted to be exhibited in Pennsylvania). Please call the Department at 717-772-2852 if such a tag is encountered).
 - (b) A legible tattoo with herd and individual identification recognized in an approved USDA Scrapie database (Scrapie tattoo – flock ID in the right ear, state postal code and letters/numbers and individual animal ID in the left ear).
 - (c) A breed registration tattoo if the animal is accompanied by a registration certificate and the tattoo is legible.
4. All animals must be free of evidence of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this should be written on the CVI.
5. Extra-label use of the rabies vaccine in goats should be discussed with the exhibitor’s veterinarian.

Fair Requirements for Departments 6, 10, 11

In cases where there is NO competition, the Fair Board reserves the right to adjust the premiums in a class where there is only one competitor.

1. Each Market Goat Wether will be weighed and assigned to a weight class. Weigh-in will be Sunday of the Fair.
2. All goats must weigh 50 lb. and not over 120 lb. The weight of each animal will be announced. Goats weighing under 50 lb. and over 120 lb. will be sent home immediately. NO re-weighs.
3. Exhibitors are limited to two (2) entries.
4. Market goats must be owned and in possession of the Exhibitor by Saturday after Mother’s Day of the current year.
5. Market goats may be does or wethers.
6. Exhibitors will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Superintendents, to accept the stall assigned without controversy; to keep their animals in an attractive appearance, and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may serve to increase the educational value of the show.

7. Restraining is prohibited. Any abuse towards any animal will not be tolerated.
8. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to know the judging schedule. Animals must be in the ring promptly on call and a failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out of competition.
9. Exhibitor must provide own bedding - no newspaper.
10. All animals must be provided with fresh water at all times and fed daily.
11. The adopted Code of Show Ring Ethics will be enforced.
